

The 2020 Census is Hiring

The 2020 Census is starting this spring. The census is important for you and your community, and you can help.

The goal of the census is to count every person living in the United States. Everyone matters, so it's important to respond. Responding to the census helps your community get its fair share of federal funding, helps your community create jobs, provide housing, prepare for emergencies, and build schools, roads, and hospitals. It also affects your voice in Congress and state and local governments.

You can help by spreading the word that we need to hire thousands of temporary census workers in Allegheny County. Although field operations are temporarily suspended we are still accepting applications. The hours are flexible and can vary-from 5-40 hours per week. Evening and weekend hours are also needed. If you know people who may be interested here or anywhere in the US, please let them know that we are hiring nationwide. Whether you need extra money or a temporary full-time job, it's a great opportunity that comes along only once every ten years.

Here's why you should apply:

- Pay is \$23.50 per hour (Allegheny County), paid weekly.
- Part-time temporary positions, flexible schedules.
- Hired for three- to eight-week stints which may be extended.
- Work in your neighborhood
- Paid training
- Vehicle expenses reimbursed at 58 cents per mile.
- Applications take about 30 minutes to complete online. No resumes or interviews are needed.
- Minimum age to work is 18. However, 17-year-olds should apply so when they turn 18 their application will be considered.
