(6-152) MOVED FIALLA-PADULA to approve the schedule of bills for June 2006 in the amount of \$147,985.28 as presented. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.

(6-153) MOVED MARTINELLI-WILSON to authorize the manager and any member of the Board of Commissioners wishing to attend a seminar sponsored by the Governor's Center for Local Government Services on National Incident Management Systems (NIMS) being held on Saturday, August 26th from 8:00 AM until 12:00 PM at the Mountain View Inn in Greensburg at a cost of \$25.00 per participant. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.

(6-154) MOVED WILSON-MARTINELLI to accept the recommendation of the manager to award the demolition contract for the Yost Cafe' to ROAC, Inc. at a cost of \$39,500.00 and authorizing the utilization of \$18,875.00 from the Emergency Contingency Fund to make up the funding deficiency. RESOLUTION NO. 16-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILKINS, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, LAND USE PLANNING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND ALLOCATING MUNICIPAL RESOURCES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000.00 TO SAID PROJECT.

(6-156) MOVED WILSON-MARTINELLI to accept Resolution #16-2006.

(6-157) MOVED MARTINELLI-WILSON to accept the recommendation of the Engineer to award the contract for the Peffer Road Sanitary Sewer project to Creative Enterprises at a low bid price of \$47,495.00. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILKINS, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PA, AUTHORIZING THE DESTRUCTION OF SPECIFIC RECORDS IN CONFORMANCE WITH RESOLUTION #08-03 AND THE MUNICIPAL RECORD MANUAL APPROVED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT RECORDS COMMITTEE ON JULY 16, 1993.

- (6-158) MOVED WILSON-MARTINELLI to adopt Resolution #17-2006 ,with the exception of the documents located on page 1, of the attached narrative summary, third item from the bottom of the page, “Other miscellaneous correspondence regarding Fire Department procedures and activities” The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.
- (6-159) MOVED MARTINELLI-WILSON to authorize the Township’s elected officials and the manager to attend the Allegheny County and Western Pennsylvania Association of Township Commissioners 34th Annual Joint Fall Conference to be held at Seven Springs from September 28th through October 1st. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.
- (6-160) MOVED FIALLA-PADULA to authorize the manager to cancel the regularly scheduled meetings of September 11, 2006 and September 25, 2006 and to schedule a meeting for September 18, 2006. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.
- (6-161) MOVED PADULA-FIALLA to accept the recommendation of Mr. Vargo to appoint John D’Alessandro of Larimer Avenue to the position of temporary summer help for the Department of Public Works, effective July 5, 2006, at an hourly rate of \$7.00. The motion was adopted by a five to one vote with Mrs. Martinelli abstaining.
- (6-162) MOVED WILSON-MARTINELLI to accept the recommendation of the Civil Service Board to extend the deadline for applications for police officer until Friday, August 4, 2006 and authorize the additional advertisement of the position in the Post-Gazette on Wednesday, July 19, 2006 and Wednesday, July 26, 2006. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.
