PUBLIC HEARING MONDAY, MARCH 30, 2015

The Public Hearing of Monday, March 30, 2015 was brought to order at 6:45 PM by President Sylvia J. Martinelli. A quorum was present as follows:

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear public comments on the demolition of fire damaged 160 Dorothy Street. Mr. Hill stated that the house suffered extensive fire damage on December 31, 2014. About a quarter of the second floor walking surface is unsupported on one end and sagging. Many of the remaining joists holding up what is left of the second floor are badly charred and burned. One or two of the interior second floor walls are hanging, unsupported, from below and are held up only by the nails into the roof joists. The listed owners of the property are deceased. A daughter of the deceased owners resided there with her son. They claim to have no insurance. Mr. Hill considers the house to be dangerous and unsafe and has condemned it.

There were no public comments.

There were no comments from the Board of Commissioners.

The meeting adjourned at 6:52 PM.
