

his wife owned another home in Wilkins, but his name has been removed and his wife does not know where he is. The home is vacant, boarded up and dilapidated.

652 Highland Avenue: This property which is owned by Raymond Powell was listed for Sheriff Sale. Mr. Powell was evicted and moved out of the home. Following that eviction the Sheriff Sale was cancelled. The outside is rotting and is full of rubbish. The interior is in poor repair. The house needs to be demolished.

661 Larimer Avenue: This property, which is owned by Paul Robedeau, who lives in Oregon has been vacant for the last three to four years. The owners claim to have purchased this property through an internet sale. The home is in poor condition with siding that is in poor repair. The property is overgrown with weeds and the retaining wall in the rear of the property is deteriorated and severely leaning. The property owners have no interest in rehabilitating the home.

565 Highland Avenue: This home, owned by Donald Nagle, has been vacant for at least six years. The property is only accessible via Ayers Alley, although it has a Highland Avenue address. The windows on the home are broken, the soffit and fascia are rotted, the siding is in poor condition.. This house is another candidate for a Fire Department training session.

521 Negley Avenue: This property, which sits at the bottom of the portion of Highland Avenue that slid in 2004 is vacant and has been for several years. The property owner, Gary Moore, is deceased. The house was broken into several times and has been boarded up by the Township. The siding on the home is bad. The interior ceiling and walls have peeling paint.

There being no further testimony or public comments, the meeting was adjourned at 6:35 PM.
