The Second Stated Meeting of Monday, March 26, 2012 was brought to order at 7:00 PM by President Sylvia J. Martinelli. A quorum was present as follows:

(105-12) MOVED WILSON-BOYD to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 12, 2012. The motion was adopted by unanimous roll call vote.

Communications:

John Schombert, Executive Director of Three Rivers Wet Weather sent an email advising that the Elected Official Basin Group Meetings will begin again in May and requesting that the Commissioners appoint a delegate and an alternate to serve for Wilkins Township. Mrs. Martinelli appointed Mr. Costa as the delegate and herself as the alternate, because meetings will be held during the day.

Citizens' Comments:

Mr. William Gabriel of 135 Powell Street requested assistance with a female resident who lives on the dead-end of Cline who speeds through the neighborhood and does not obey stop signs on a daily basis.

(106-12) MOVED WILSON-CRINER accepting the recommendation of the Manager to authorize Chester Engineers to prepare specifications and bid books and to advertise for bids on the Roland Road Paving Project and the Dowling Avenue Sanitary Sewer Project.

(107-12) MOVED WILSON-BOYD accepting the recommendation of the Manager to hire Dawn Bingham as a permanent part-time employee at an hourly rate per Collective Bargaining Agreement of \$11.59 per hour, effective immediately.

(108-12) MOVED COSTA-BOYD authorizing the Manager to notify the Turtle Creek Valley Council of Governments that area-wide funding in the amount of \$9,031 will be used to demolish the duplex located at 113-115 Grandview Avenue.

(109-12) MOVED BOYD-COSTA accepting the recommendation of the Solicitor to settle the tax assessment appeal for lot/block 574-C-24.

(110-12) MOVED WILSON-BOYD approving the request from the Senior Citizens Group to use the Community Center for one additional hour each Thursday for the purpose of providing group yoga classes.

(111-12) MOVED COSTA-CRINER approving the request of the Penhurst Civic Association for the appropriation of \$200.00 in accordance with the First Class Township Code.
