

(258-12) MOVED WILSON-COSTA authorizing the manager to execute the Transportation Impact Study (TIS) Scoping Meeting Application for the WalMart project.

(259-12) MOVED COSTA-WILSON to accept the recommendation of Chester Engineers to make final payment to W.A. Petrakis in the amount of \$4,348.84 for the Dowling Avenue Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project.

(260-12) MOVED WILSON-COSTA authorizing the continued participation with the Vacant and Blighted Property Strategy Development Project and authorizing payment of the local share of \$500.

(261-12) MOVED BOYD-COSTA to explore interest in developing Green Building Incentives for the Township.

(262-12) MOVED WILSON-COSTA to accept the recommendation of the Recreation Advisory Committee to appoint Ms. Susan Delanko-Defuccia as the Zumba instructor. The motion was adopted by a 4-1 vote with Mrs. Martinelli abstaining.

Mr. Costa mentioned that he attended the Three Rivers Wet Weather Conference with Mr. Ed Bruener. Information is available in the Managers Office.

Mrs. Martinelli announced that two ALCOSAN Representatives came to the Senior Citizens Meeting and informed them that they will have to pay \$400 more for sewage per year.

Mr. Boyd mentioned that Green Initiatives could be cheaper than ALCOSAN and thinks it may be wise to revisit rain barrels and rain gardens to offset part of this cost.
