## E-WASTE SERVICE IS BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2019

- E-Waste collection is a new service to residents in Wilkins Township offered by Republic Services. There is no additional charge for this service. E-Waste can now be safely collected from each home by calling 724-887-9400. Data destruction is assured.
- E-Waste will include televisions, computers, monitors, VCR and DVD players, printers, fax machines, cable boxes, keyboards, gaming equipment and similar electronic waste.
- There will be a limit of two televisions and/or computer monitors during each collection. Residents must call to arrange for collection. Residents will then be asked to describe the items they wish to be collected. Residents will be told when and where on their property the E-Waste will be collected. These E-Waste items will NOT be placed at the curb with the weekly waste. E-Waste collection will be made with a separate truck and crew and may not be on the same day as your regular waste collection.

#### RECYCLING IS MANDATORY AND IMPORTANT

- Your recyclables will have new life as future products.

\*PLASTICS #'s 1 & 2 ONLY

Cans - aluminum, steel, bi-metal (rinsed of excess food residue)

**Paper** – most types as follows: Newspapers; inserts Junk Mail Magazines, catalogs

Books - phone, paper, and hardback Books (remove hardback covers)

Office Paper; shredded paper (tied inside a clear plastic bag)

Paperboard (chipboard), e.g., pasta, cereal, tissue, baking mix boxes Toilet paper rolls, paper towel rolls

**Corrugated Cardboard** (must be flat and cut to fit [not wedged] into container)

Pizza Box Tops (no residual food)

Juice and soy milk boxes

**Dairy and Juice Cartons** with gable tops (only types with a recycling number)

**Egg Cartons** – paper types only
